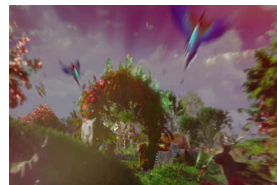
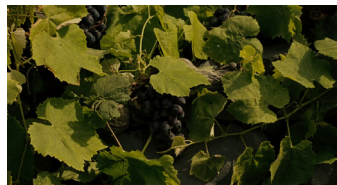
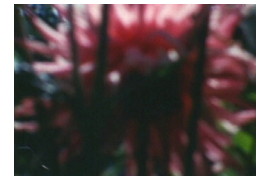
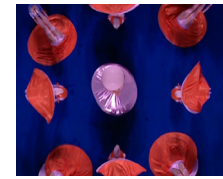
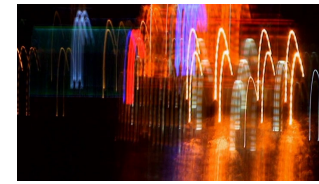
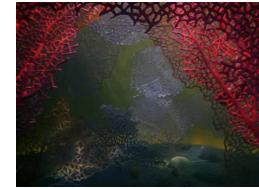
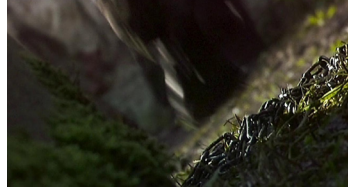
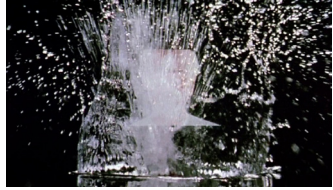


THE ENCHANTED GARDEN

The beauties of nature appear to me now even more alluring than in my youth, because my intercourse with the world has formed without vitiating my taste. [23]



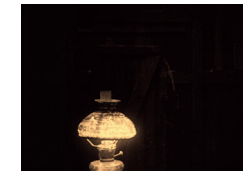
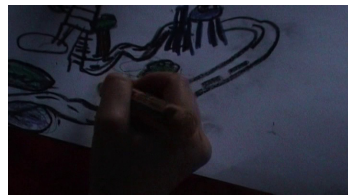
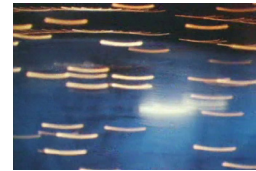
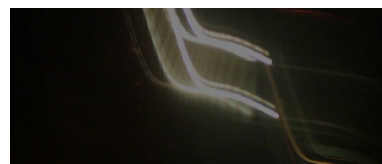
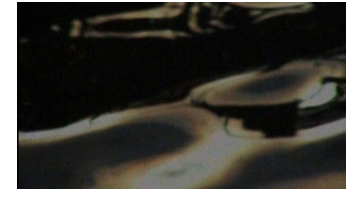
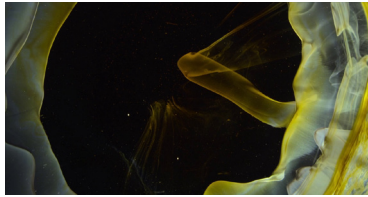
THE NEON LIGHT'S AND RED CHEEKS

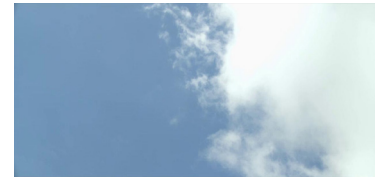
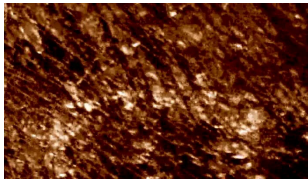
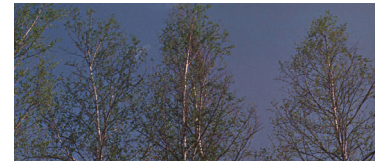
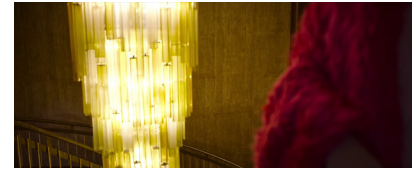


**DELICIOUS CHEESE AND WINE

The cake then magically appeared out of the realm of uncertainty.



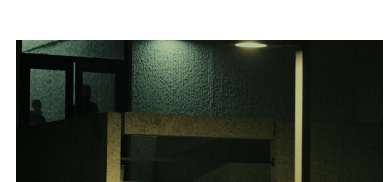
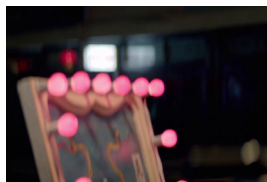
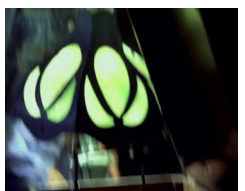
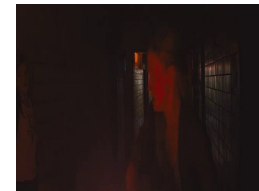
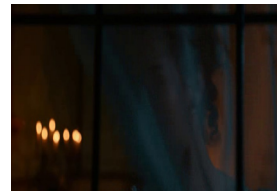
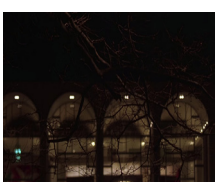
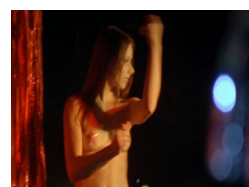

But since bread is an artificial thing, its form is an accident. [54]

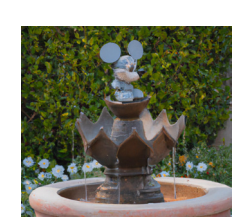
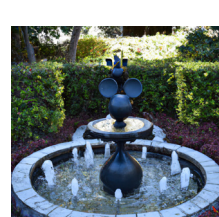
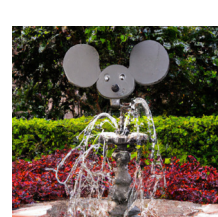
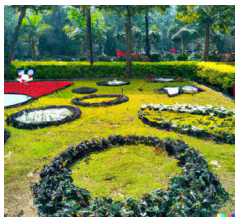
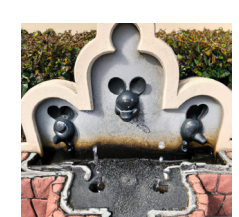
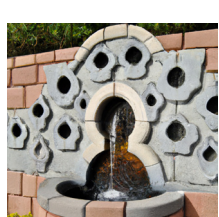
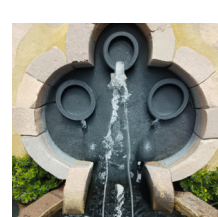
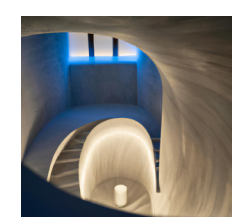
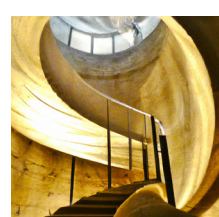
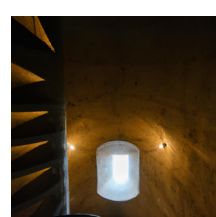
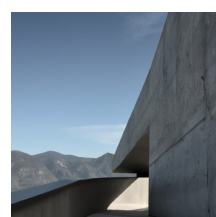
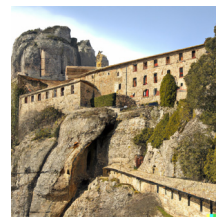
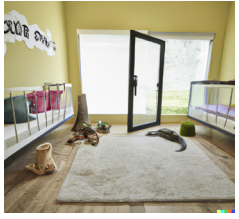


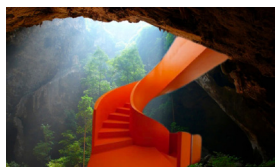
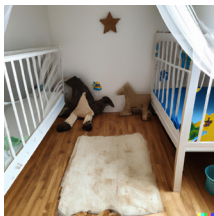
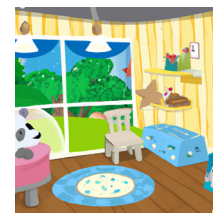
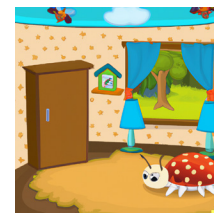
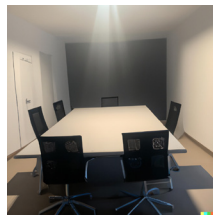
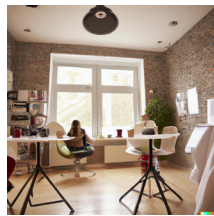
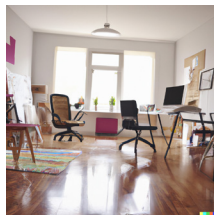
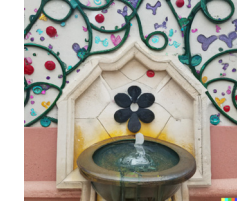
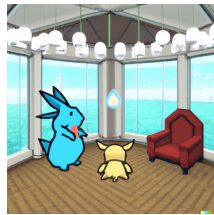
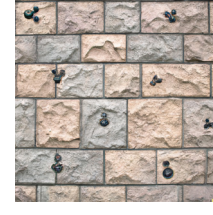
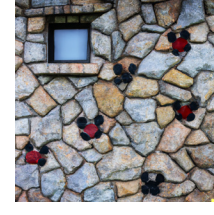
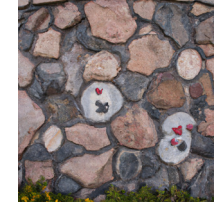
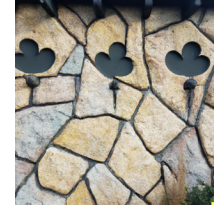
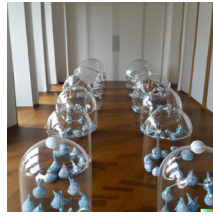
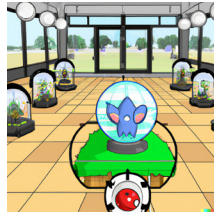
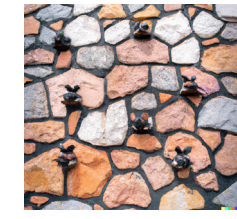
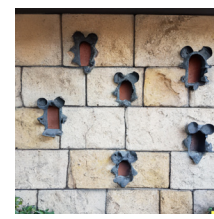
